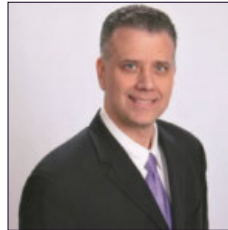

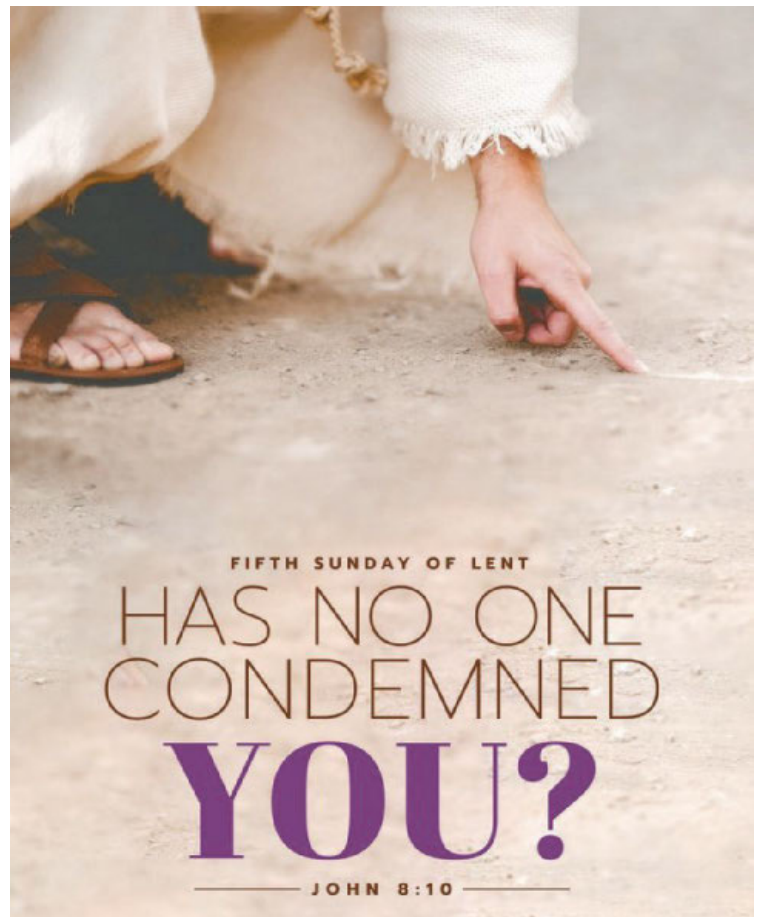

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

HAS NO ONE
CONDEMNED
YOU?

— JOHN 8:10 —

The memory of the great works of God in the history of Israel, which enabled them to leave the captivity of Egypt and cross the Red Sea, was for each of them a guarantee of God's care over their nation and at the same time the fulfillment of the prophetic announcements that one day the Messiah will come, who will "open the way to the desert (...), provide water and rivers in the wilderness to give water to the chosen people (...), so that they can speak of His glory." And indeed, the Lord did these great things for them, as today's Psalm says. Of course, nothing comes spontaneously. Each of them had to make this journey of departure and transition and actively participate in them, contributing to the fact that these great works of God were fulfilled before their eyes, and therefore they can also hope that with his (successors') activity, God will fulfill the next announcements. It happened once, it will happen in the future. Jesus Christ is this future announcement of God to fulfill them and bring about a new exit from slavery and a new transition to life, through His saving work on the cross. Paul, aware of this and believing that Jesus is the fulfiller of God's messianic prophecies, "counts everything as loss because of the supreme value of knowing Christ Jesus", wanting to take an active part in the saving work of Jesus. "For His sake he has stripped

himself of all things and counted them as rubbish that he might gain Christ and be found in Him." First of all, through his experience of suffering and persecution, he takes part in the sufferings of Jesus in order to also take part in His victory, i.e. in the resurrection. Meanwhile, in the Gospel, Jesus saves an adulterous woman burdened with the sin of a system that lacked the true God, showing her mercy, forgiveness of sins and the possibility of a new start now with Jesus, so that she, like every other injured person, could participate in the glory of God. How many of us are in a similar situation? Having experienced God's grace for the forgiveness of our sins, having been thus gained by Christ, let us run "towards the goal marked out for us, to win the prize for which God is calling us upwards in Christ Jesus."

STOP ASSISTED SUICIDE IN ILLINOIS - ADD YOUR VOICE TO THE OPPOSITION

Please contact your state senator and representative now to express your opposition to Senate Bill 9 & House Bill 1328, a proposed piece of legislation that seeks to legalize assisted suicide in Illinois. The proponents of this bill are actively urging lawmakers to pass SB 9 & HB 1328. In keeping with our faith traditions, legalizing assisted suicide goes against the Church's teachings on the sanctity and dignity of human life. It undermines the value of each human person, particularly those who are vulnerable. Laws permitting assisted suicide pose significant risks to the poor, marginalized, and disabled, who may face pressure to end their lives rather than receive the care and compassion they need and deserve. There are documented cases from states where assisted suicide has been legalized, where individuals with rare or life-threatening conditions were denied necessary medical treatment and were instead offered life-ending prescriptions.

Illinois does not need to legalize assisted suicide. What we truly need is increased access to quality health care, enhanced palliative care options, and loving and compassionate support services for those at the end of their life.

These are the alternatives that uphold the dignity of every person.

Wspomnienie z historii Izraela wielkich dzieł Bożych, jakie umożliwiły im wyjście z niewoli Egiptu i przejście przez M. Czerwone, było dla każdego z nich gwarancją opieki Bożej nad ich narodem a zarazem wypełnienia zapowiedzi prorockich, że pewnego dnia przyjdzie Mesjasz, który „otworzy drogę pustyni (...), dostarczy wody i rzek na pustkowiu, aby napoić lud wybrany (...), by ten mógł opowiadać Jego chwałę”. I rzeczywiście, Pan uczynił te wielkie rzeczy dla nich, jak mówi dzisiejszy Psalm. Oczywiście nic nie przychodzi samoistnie. Każdy z nich musiał odbyć tę wędrówkę wyjścia i przejścia oraz w nich czynnie uczestniczyć, przyczyniając się do tego, że te wielkie dzieła Boże spełniły się na ich oczach, a zatem może też mieć nadzieję, że z jego (następców) aktywnością Bóg wypełni następne zapowiedzi. Tak się stało kiedyś, tak się stanie w przyszłości. Jezus Chrystus jest tą przysłą zapowiedzią Boga, by je wypełnić i spowodować nowe wyjście z niewoli i nowe przejście do życia, przez Jego dzieło zbawcze na krzyżu. Paweł świadomy tego i wierząc, że Jezus jest tym wypełnieniem Bożych prorocत्व mesjańskich, „wszystko uznaje za stratę ze względu na najwyższą wartość poznania Chrystusa Jezusa”, chcąc wziąć czynny udział, ze swojej strony, w dziele zbawczym Jezusa. „Dla Niego wylał się ze wszystkiego i

uznać to za śmieci, byleby pozyskał Chrystusa i znalazł się w Nim”. Przede wszystkim, poprzez swoje doświadczenie cierpienia i prześladowań, bierze udział w cierpieniach Jezusa, by mieć też udział w Jego zwycięstwie, tj. w zmartwychwstaniu. Tymczasem Jezus w Ewangelii ratuje kobietę cudzołożną obciążoną grzechem poniekąd systemu, w której brakowało prawdziwego Boga, okazując jej miłosierdzie, przebaczenie grzechów i możliwość nowego startu teraz z Jezusem, by i ona, jak każdy inny poszkodowany, mógł uczestniczyć w chwale Bożej. Ilu z nas jest w podobnej sytuacji? Doznawszy Bożej łaski przebaczenia naszych grzechów, będąc tak zdobytym przez Chrystusa, biegnijmy „ku wyznaczonej nam mecie, ku nagrodzie, do jakiej Bóg wzywa w górę, w Chrystusie Jezusie”.

- ◆ Co Jezus mógł pisać palcem po ziemi? Co i komu chciał przez to powiedzieć?
- ◆ Jak silna jest we mnie tendencja do bezlitosnego oceniania i osądzania innych?
- ◆ Co rodzi się we mnie, gdy słyszę Jezusa, który mówi mi dziś: Kto z was jest bez grzechu, niech pierwszy rzuci kamieniem?
- ◆ Kogo bardziej przypominam w moich codziennych postawach – uczonych w Piśmie i faryzeuszy z ich obłudnym czasem legalizmem czy wielkodusznego Jezusa, który – choć jako jedyny miałby prawo do osądu – stosuje prawo miłosierdzia i przebaczenia?
- ◆ Jak patrzenie na moją historię życia w świetle słowa Bożego pomaga mi dostrzec, oprócz moich grzechów i upadków, także to, jak bardzo jestem umiłowany przez Boga, który nigdy ze mnie nie rezygnuje?
- ◆ Jak często korzystam z sakramentu pokuty i pojednania, w którym Bóg przekonuje mnie o tym, że ostatnie słowo nie należy do grzechu i śmierci, ale do nawrócenia, przebaczenia i łaski komunii z Bogiem?

El recuerdo de las grandes obras de Dios en la historia de Israel, que les permitieron salir del cautiverio de Egipto y cruzar el Mar Rojo, fue para cada uno de ellos una garantía del cuidado de Dios sobre su nación y al mismo tiempo el cumplimiento de los anuncios proféticos de que un día vendrá el Mesías que "abrirá camino al desierto (...), proveerá agua y ríos en el desierto para dar agua al pueblo elegido (...), para que pueda hablar de su gloria". Y efectivamente, el Señor hizo estas grandes cosas con ellos, como dice el Salmo de hoy. Por supuesto, nada surge de forma espontánea. Cada uno de ellos tuvo que hacer este camino de partida y transición y participar activamente en ellos, contribuyendo a que estas grandes obras de Dios se cumplieran ante sus ojos, y por lo tanto, también pueden esperar que con su actividad (la de sus sucesores), Dios cumpla los próximos anuncios. Sucedió una vez, sucederá en el futuro. Jesucristo es este anuncio futuro de Dios para cumplirlos y provocar una nueva salida de la esclavitud y una nueva transición a la vida, a través de su obra salvadora en la cruz. Pablo, consciente de ello y creyendo que Jesús es el cumplidor de las profecías mesiánicas de Dios, "considera todo como pérdida a causa del valor supremo de conocer a Cristo Jesús", queriendo tomar parte activa, por su parte, en la obra salvífica de Jesús. "Por amor a él se despojó de

todas las cosas y las tuvo por basura, para ganar a Cristo y ser hallado en él". En primer lugar, a través de su experiencia de sufrimiento y persecución, participa en los sufrimientos de Jesús para participar también en su victoria, es decir, en la resurrección. Mientras tanto, en el Evangelio, Jesús salva a una mujer adúltera cargada con el pecado de un sistema que carecía del Dios verdadero, mostrándole misericordia, perdón de los pecados y la posibilidad de un nuevo comienzo ahora con Jesús, para que ella, como cualquier otro herido, pudiera participar de la gloria de Dios. ¿Cuántos de nosotros estamos en una situación similar? Habiendo experimentado la gracia de Dios para el perdón de nuestros pecados, habiendo sido así ganados por Cristo, corramos "hacia la meta que nos ha sido señalada, para alcanzar el premio al que Dios nos llama hacia arriba en Cristo Jesús".

Los defensores argumentan que esta legislación acabará con el sufrimiento al final de la vida. Todos estamos de acuerdo en que nadie debería sufrir innecesariamente ni tener que ver a un ser querido experimentar un dolor y un sufrimiento innecesarios. Afortunadamente, ahora existen maneras efectivas para hacer que una persona esté más cómoda al final de la vida a través de cuidados paliativos, que utilizan equipos dirigidos por médicos para cuidar a la persona en su totalidad: física, emocional, social y espiritualmente; para aliviar los síntomas y el estrés relacionados con las enfermedades graves y los efectos secundarios del tratamiento.

La Asociación Médica Estadounidense (AMA, por sus siglas en inglés) ha resumido bien el argumento contra el suicidio asistido: "El suicidio asistido por un médico es fundamentalmente incompatible con el papel del médico como sanador, sería difícil o imposible de controlar y plantearía graves riesgos sociales".

El suicidio asistido no es la solución compasiva para quienes están sufriendo. A través de cuidados paliativos, un mayor acceso al cuidado de la salud mental, y un apoyo familiar y comunitario más fuerte, los proveedores y las familias están encontrando mejores maneras de acompañar a estas personas de un modo compasivo, que demuestra amor y respeto por la dignidad de cada vida humana.



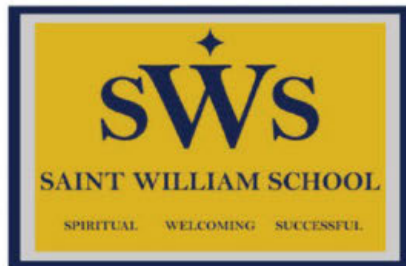

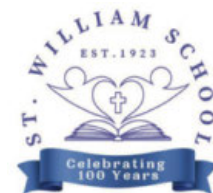
