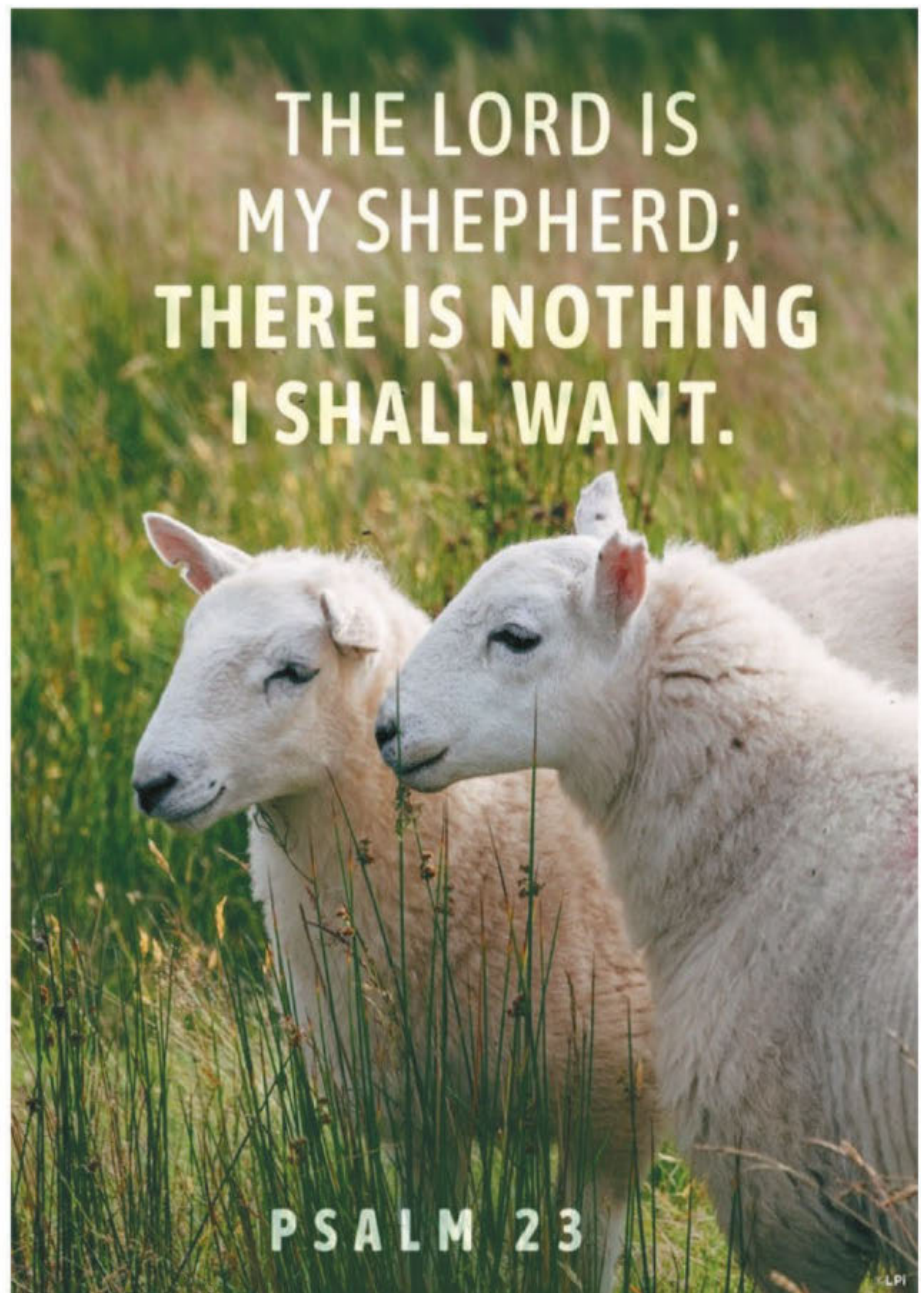

Solemnity of All Saints and Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed

This year, the commemoration of all the deceased falls on a Sunday, so we have a rare opportunity to speak about it today. This commemoration is connected to yesterday's Solemnity of All Saints, because in both cases, it concerns all the deceased who, in some way, eternally participate in God's goodness, from which they emerged as previously created. Those who, following the example of Jesus Christ, lived lives in accordance with God's will in holiness and cooperation with His grace present in His Church, after their death experience entry into the kingdom of God; as Jesus himself says, "they will attain resurrection to life" (in God). However, those who fell short of

this holiness during their lives can count on God's mercy, through our intercession, that is, through our prayers and the indulgences we gain for them, which have their source in the richness of grace drawn from Christ's saving sacrifice. Jesus also speaks of "resurrection to eternal damnation" in the case of those who destroyed God's order in this world, directly opposing God's goodness or advocating for a coalition of evil and Satan against God. In the first two cases, he speaks of heaven and purgatory, and in the latter, of hell. It is usually unclear who goes where after death, even when all signs point to one state or another (e.g., Hitler or Stalin). Everything depends on God's mercy and the state of a person's soul at the moment of death. In the case of heaven, however, there is a certain gap reserved for the Church when it

conducts the beatification (canonization) process, declaring someone a saint as a result. Only these people are known for certain to be saints in heaven. Today's readings speak of the souls of the righteous, who are in God's hands; of the resurrection of the dead, who, thanks to Jesus, have access to the Father's Kingdom. Let us not forget to pray today for our deceased loved ones, entrusting them to the Divine Mercy.

LIST OD KSIĘDZA RYSZARDA

Uroczystość Wszystkich Świętych i Wspomnienie Wszystkich Zmarłych

W tym roku wspomnienie wszystkich zmarłych przypada na niedzielę, stąd mamy rzadką okazję mówić o niej dzisiaj. Wspomnienie to łączy się z wczorajszą uroczystością Wszystkich Świętych, bo w rezultacie i w pierwszym i w drugim przypadku chodzi o wszystkich zmarłych, którzy w jakiś sposób partycypują wiecznie w dobroci Boga, z której wyszli będąc wcześniej stworzeni. Ci, którzy za przykładem Jezusa Chrystusa, prowadzili życie zgodnie z wolą Bożą w świętości i współpracy z Jego łaską obecną w Jego Kościele, po swojej śmierci doznają wejścia do królestwa Bożego, jak mówi sam Jezus „dostąpią zmartwychwstania do życia” (w Bogu). Tym jednak, którym brakowało trochę do tej

świętości w drodze ich życia, mogą liczyć na Boże miłosierdzie, za naszym wstawiennictwem, to znaczy dzięki naszym modlitwom i zyskiwanym dla nich odpustom, które mają swoje źródło w bogactwie łask czerpanej z ofiary zbawczej Chrystusa. Jezus mówi także o „zmartwychwstaniu na wieczne potępienie”, w przypadku tych, którzy niszczyli porządek Boży na tym świecie, występując wprost przeciw dobroci Bożej, albo opowiadając się za budowaniem swoistej koalicji zła z szatanem przeciw Bogu. W pierwszych dwóch przypadkach jest mowa o niebie i czyszczeniu, a w tym ostatnim, o piekle. Z reguły nie wiadomo, kto gdzie się dostaje po śmierci, nawet wtedy, kiedy wszystkie znaki mogą wskazywać na taki czy inny stan (np. Hitler czy Stalin). Wszystko zależy od miłosierdzia Bożego oraz stanu duszy człowieka w chwili jego

śmierci. W przypadku nieba jest jednak pewna wyrwa, zarezerwowana dla Kościoła, kiedy ten przeprowadza proces beatyfikacyjny (kanonizacyjny), ogłaszając w jego wyniku kogoś świętym. O tych tylko ludziach wiemy na pewno, że są świętymi w niebie. Dzisiejsze czytania mówią o duszach sprawiedliwych, będących w ręku Boga; o wskrzeszeniu zmarłych, którzy dzięki Jezusowi mają przystęp do Królestwa Ojca. Nie zapomnijmy dzisiaj pomodlić się za naszych bliskich zmarłych, polecając ich Bożemu Miłosierdziu.

Solemnidad de Todos los Santos y Commemoracion de todos los difuntos

Este año, la conmemoración de todos los difuntos cae en domingo, por lo que hoy tenemos una oportunidad excepcional para hablar de ello. Esta conmemoración está relacionada con la Solemnidad de Todos los Santos de ayer, porque en ambos casos concierne a todos los difuntos que, de alguna manera, participan eternamente de la bondad de Dios, de la que surgieron como previamente creados. Quienes, siguiendo el ejemplo de Jesucristo, vivieron conforme a la voluntad de Dios en santidad y cooperación con su gracia presente en su Iglesia, tras su muerte entran en el reino de Dios; como dice el propio Jesús, «alcanzarán la resurrección a la vida» (en Dios). Sin embargo, quienes no alcanzaron esta santidad durante su vida pueden

contar con la misericordia de Dios posteriormente, a través de nuestra intercesión, es decir, mediante nuestras oraciones y las indulgencias que obtenemos por ellos, las cuales tienen su fuente en la riqueza de la gracia proveniente del sacrificio salvífico de Cristo. Jesús también habla de la "resurrección a la condenación eterna" en el caso de quienes destruyeron el orden divino en este mundo, oponiéndose directamente a su bondad o abogando por una coalición del mal y Satanás contra Dios. En los dos primeros casos, habla del cielo y el purgatorio, y en el segundo, del infierno. Generalmente no está claro quién va a dónde después de la muerte, incluso cuando todo apunta a un estado u otro (por ejemplo, Hitler o Stalin). Todo depende de la misericordia de Dios y del estado del alma de la persona al momento de la muerte. En el caso del cielo, sin embargo, existe un cierto vacío reservado para la

Iglesia cuando lleva a cabo el proceso de beatificación (canonización), declarando a alguien santo como resultado. Solo estas personas tienen la certeza de ser santas en el cielo. Las lecturas de hoy hablan de las almas de los justos, que están en manos de Dios; de la resurrección de los muertos, que, gracias a Jesús, tienen acceso al Reino del Padre. No olvidemos orar hoy por nuestros seres queridos difuntos, encomendándolos a la Divina Misericordia.

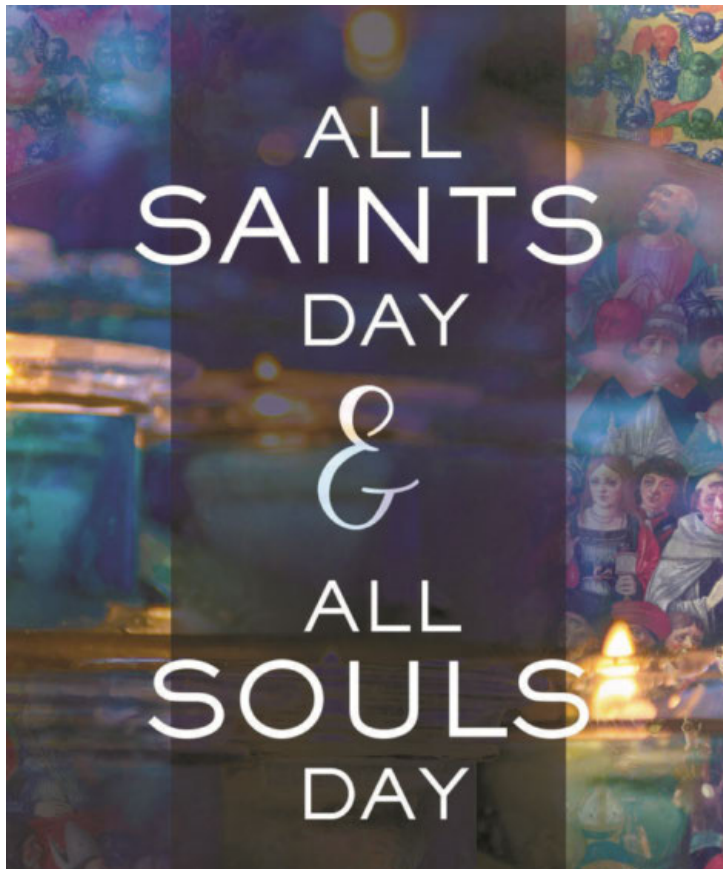

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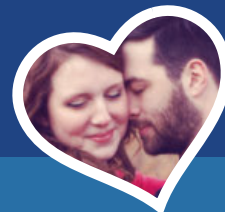
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
